**Your application under the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009 (GIPA Act)***

On **6 June 2018**, we accepted transfer of your application from Service NSW for the following information under the GIPA Act:

- 1. Horizontal and vertical alignments for Mona Vale Road East Upgrade.*
- 2. Details of safety arrestor bed, and separation barrier and wildlife under & overpasses and pedestrian and cyclist access.*

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) receives and acknowledges applications under the GIPA Act before sending them to the relevant transport agency to make a decision. Your application will be processed by Roads and Maritime Services.

**When will we decide your application?**

Under the GIPA Act, your application must be decided within 20 working days being **5 July 2018**.

Please note that if we are required by the GIPA Act to retrieve records from archives and/or consult with any third party we can extend the decision date.

If your application has not been decided by the decision date, your application is considered to have been refused (a deemed refusal). Should this occur, we will continue to make a (late) decision and refund your application fee. You may apply for a review of the deemed refusal decision.

In some circumstances, the agency may decide that some information about your application may be of interest to other members of the public and decide to include details of the application in its disclosure log. Should this occur, the agency would ask if you object to details of your application being included in the disclosure log when notifying you of the outcome of your application. The decision of an agency to include details in its disclosure log is a reviewable decision.

### **What are your review rights?**

I have enclosed a fact sheet that explains your rights to apply for a review of decisions made under the GIPA Act.
