On 20 October 2016,

I, Clarinda Campbell, of 33 James Craig Road, Rozelle, NSW affirm:

- 1. I am the Manager, Information and Privacy Unit within the Government and Information Service Branch at Roads and Maritime Services (Roads and Maritime). I have delegation from the Chief Executive of Roads and Maritime to make decisions responding to *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009* (GIPA Act) applications. I have held this position for approximately 2 years.
- 2. On 1 July 2016 the GIPA Act application from Phillip Walker (Application) was received by the Resource and Compliance Unit (RCU) at Transport for New South Wales (TfNSW). The RCU is responsible for the initial processing and acknowledgment of GIPA Act applications across the transport cluster (Roads and Maritime, TfNSW, Sydney Trains, NSW Trains and State Transit Authority). A copy of the Application is at Annexure 1. The Application sought:
 - Conclusions of design an costing for overpass proposal (c/- Member Rob Stokes) Mona Vale Road East Upgrade, at intersection with Samuel St and Ponderosa Pde (estimated at \$50 million)
- 3. The Application was acknowledged by the RCU and was provided to the Information and Privacy Unit at Roads and Maritime.
- 4. Upon receipt of the Application, the matter was allocated by me to Janet Bak who is a Senior Access and Compliance Officer within the Information and Privacy Unit at Roads and Maritime.

- 5. Roads and Maritime is split into eight Divisions, each responsible for an area of Roads and Maritime's functions. I determined that any documents responding to the Application were likely to only be held in the Infrastructure Development Division because:
 - a. This is the Division responsible for the Mona Vale Road East Upgrade;
 - This is the Division largely responsible for major infrastructure projects (noting some that maintenance projects are completed by the Asset Maintenance Division);
 - c. Other areas of Roads and Maritime are unlikely to be involved in assessing proposals of this nature;
 - d. This Division had previously provided documents in response to a similar application relating to the same Project; and
- 6. The above view is based on the knowledge I have gained of Roads and Maritime's functions in the last 2 years, and the evident link between the Application and the work of the Infrastructure Development Division.
- . 7. On Monday 4 July 2016, Ms Bak sent an email to Jeff McCarthy, the Director of Roads and Maritime's Infrastructure Development Division. On 4 July 2016, Mr McCarthy's Executive Assistant asked Ms Bak to liaise with Michael Tansey, the then Acting General Manager Greater Sydney Program Office. A copy of this email chain is Annexure 2.
 - 8. On 4 July 2016, Ms Bak emailed Mr Tansey requesting that he have searches undertaken to respond to the Application. A copy of that email is **Annexure 3**.
 - 9. On 8 July 2016, Ms Bak emailed Mr Tansey to confirm the terms of the Application. A copy of that email is **Annexure 4**.
 - 10. On 8 July 2016, Ms Bak received an email from Mr Tansey which attached a Record of Searches. A copy of that email and attachment are **Annexure 5**.
 - 11. The Record of Searches was signed by Mr Tansey and Mr Matty Mathivanar, Project Manager. The document indicated to me that Mr Mathivanar had taken five hours to complete searches for documents responding to the Application. Mr Mathivanar had also made the following comment in the document:

There was no consideration given for grade separation of Mona Vale Road and Ponderosa Parade/Samuel Street intersection.

During the preparation of the REF, the Applicant requested and [sic] alternative alignment for the road upgrade that went through Ingleside. This option is addressed in the REF.

- 12. REF is an acronym for 'Review of Environmental Factors' which I understand is a document produced in the course of obtaining approvals for infrastructure projects. I understood that the reference to the REF related to a separate suggestion put forward by the Applicant and that document was not relevant to the Application.
- 13. In light of the searches carried out by Mr Mathivanar as documented in the search certificate, I was satisfied that reasonable searches had been conducted and there were no documents responding to the Application.

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14. Consequently, on 18 July 2016, I exercised my delegation to determine the Application and, based on the outcome of the searches conducted by others, decided that the requested information was not held by Roads and Maritime. A copy of the decision is at **Annexure 6**.


Mona Vale Road upgrade work





Mona Vale Road East upgrade: Investigations are under way for the 3.2km upgrade of Mona Vale Road to four lanes between Manor Road and Foley Street. Work to build two lanes in each direction between Foley and Daydream Streets is expected to form the first stage.

Mona Vale Road West upgrade: Investigations are continuing for the upgrade of Mona Vale Road to four lanes between McCarrs Creek Road and Powder Works Road.

Community comment: The community would be invited to comment on an early concept design for the proposed upgrades later this year.



1. Your access application

1.1 On 1 July 2016 we received your access application under the GIPA Act for the following information:

Conclusions of design and costings for overpass proposal (c/- Member Rob Stokes) Mona Vale Road East Upgrade, at intersection with Samuel St and Ponderosa Pde (estimated at \$50 million).

2. Searches for information

2.1 Under the GIPA Act agencies must conduct reasonable searches to locate the requested government information. We requested information from the Roads and Maritime Infrastructure Development Division.

3. Decision

- 3.1 I am authorised by the Principal Officer for purposes of section 9(3) of the GIPA Act to decide your access application.
- 3.2 Under section 58(1)(b) of the GIPA Act I decided that Roads and Maritime does not hold the requested information.

4. **Reasons for Decision**

- 4.1 Under section 9(1) of the GIPA Act you have a legally enforceable right to access the requested information, unless there is an overriding public interest against its disclosure.
- 4.2 Under section 5 of the GIPA Act there is a presumption in favour of disclosing government information, unless there is an overriding public interest against its disclosure.
- 4.3 The Infrastructure Development Division has provided the following comments in response to searches for the information you have requested:

"There was no consideration given for grade separation of Mona Vale Road and Ponderosa Parade/Samuel Street intersection.

During the preparation of the REF, the Applicant requested an alternate alignment for the road upgrade that went through Ingleside. This option is addressed in the REF".

5. Review rights

If you disagree with my decision, you may apply for it to be reviewed by seeking:

- an internal review by another officer of this agency, who is no less senior than me;
- an external review by the NSW Information Commissioner: or
- an external review by the NSW Civil and Administrative Tribunal (NCAT).

You have 20 working days from the date of this letter to apply for an internal review and 40 working days to apply for an external review by NCAT.

6. More information

For your information and assistance I enclose a fact sheet explaining your rights to have our decision reviewed.
